








Strong tidal currents occur around Tofino, even during periods of small waves. Fast moving tidal currents can be found along the shorelines, caused by rising and falling tides in deep inlets.

Tidal currents may not dissipate until the tide turns and water users caught in these currents may be swept long distances. Back eddies of calm water may be found close to shore.

Always plan your activities according to the tide.
